Membership

Library cards are **FREE** for residents of the Town of Rainy River, the Township of Dawson, the Township of Lake of the Woods, and the Township of Morley. A resident is someone who lives in or pays taxes in these places.

Cards are also free for members of the libraries in Atikokan, Baudette, Emo, Fort Frances, and Big Grassy First Nation. You must present your Atikokan, Baudette, Emo, Fort Frances, or Big Grassy card to receive your membership at Rainy River.

Children must have a parent or guardian co-sign their membership.

NEW: Non-residents may buy a card for \$40 per year. If you are only here for the summer, you can buy a six-month membership for \$25.

If you lose your library card, tell us as soon as possible. The replacement card fee is \$1. Staff will update your personal information every two years. Please report changes of address, telephone number and email as soon as possible.

How long can I keep my items?

All Books and Audio **21 days**
Movies and Magazines **7 days**

Books from Interlibrary Loan will have a special due date. Please check your receipt. Dates are shown as “#/#” - for example, March 26 would be “3/26.”

What happens if my items are late?

Fines on all items are 50¢ per day (excluding Sundays and Mondays). The maximum fine per item is \$10.00. A replacement fine will be charged on lost or damaged items.

What services do you have at the Library?

FREE INTERNET ACCESS - WIFI

Our WIFI is on 24/7. Use network RRPL Public 1. We have four public internet access computers. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult to use our terminals.

COPY, FAX & LAMINATE

All printing and copying is 50¢ per page, for black and white or color. All faxing (sending or receiving to any number) is \$1 per page. Laminating is \$1 per item/page.

OVERNIGHT BOOK RETURN

You can return your items at the drop box outside the library.

INTERLIBRARY LOAN

Access libraries near and far. If we don't have it, we will do our best to get it. **Please note we are unable to request items published in the current or previous calendar year.**

TALKING BOOKS

We have three DAISY-format audio players from the CNIB. Our library has a deposit collection of over 800 talking books for you.

CHILDREN'S CRAFT TABLE AND PLAY AREA

Now open again! Enjoy our crafts, puppets and toys anytime. Children aged eight and under must be accompanied by an adult while using the Library.

Do you take donations?

Yes! The library can accept items in good condition – such as gently used books, CDs, and DVDs for adults, teens and children.

The Library is unable to take: damaged, stained or dirty books; cassettes or videos copied from originals; audio tapes and VHS cassettes; moldy or damp books; textbooks; National Geographic magazines; old encyclopedia sets; or Reader's Digest Condensed Books. If we are unable to add your donation to the collection, we will use it in our annual book sale. This helps raise funds to buy new items each year.
