# OUR STORY 2014

## In 2014, your public library...

- Loaned 17,187 items
- Registered 75 new members
- Added 1,763 new items
- Provided free internet access to 2,235 users – an increase of 13%!
- Provided 43 free computer lessons
- Logged 44,588 Facebook impressions and 5,870 visits to our website
- Loaned 2,151 audiobooks and ebooks by internet download
- Held 23 library programs attended by 282 adults and children
- Gratefully received 171 hours of volunteer assistance

## HIGHLIGHTS OF 2014

- **APRIL:** The library receives a \$500 donation from New Gold Inc. to purchase talking books.
- **APRIL:** New furniture, toys and signage were added to the children's section thanks to a \$2,385 grant from the Canada Post Community Foundation.
- **MAY:** The library receives a grant from the Ontario Summer Experience program to hire summer student Shauna Moen. Shauna oversees the Eurkea! TD Summer Reading club.
- **JUNE:** The Library migrates to the cloud-based Apollo circulation system, created by Biblionix. Apollo brings downloadable ebooks and audiobooks into the catalogue for the first time.
- **JULY-AUGUST:** Our TD Summer Readers have a seven-week Crafty Challenge with the John M. Cuelenare Public Library in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan. Crazy crafts are posted on Pinterest, and the craziest crafters at each library win a prize.
- **NOVEMBER:** Trainer Jeff Marchuk begins a new season of free computer lessons thanks to the Youth Interns at Community Access Sites (YI@CAS) program.
- **DECEMBER:** The Library's 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Winter's Here! Bird Count finds 21 species and 725 individual birds.
