# HIGHLIGHTS OF 2015

- MAY: The library receives a grant from the Ontario Summer Experience program to hire summer student Hayley Arpin. Hayley completes the first inventory of the library using our Apollo system.
- MAY: The Library receives the second of three grants from the Ontario Library Capacity Fund (OLCF). The Fund helps the Library buy new materials and eBooks.
- SEPTEMBER: RRPL joins the growing network of libraries using the Axis360 eBook service, provided by Whitehots and Baker & Taylor.
- DECEMBER: Thanks to the efforts of 10 volunteers, the Library's Christmas Bird Count finds 24 species and 983 individual birds.
