

Visiting the Library During the COVID-19 Pandemic

As allowed by the province, the Library re-opened to the public on **July 2, 2021**. Our new, permanent hours are:

Tuesdays & Thursdays, 1 pm-6 pm. Fridays & Saturdays, 10 am-2pm.

Until further notice, we can offer you doors-open service on all four days.

We are so glad to see you again! While we are now in Stage 3, some COVID-related restrictions still remain. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience these may cause. Please follow staff direction – we are doing our best to make the Library safe and welcoming.

1. When you enter the Library, please follow the arrows, instructions and signs posted on the floor. Hand sanitizer will be available on the front table. **All patrons are required to wear masks, as ordered by the Northwestern Health Unit.**
2. Go to the main desk for all services per usual.
3. For now, the Library is unable to offer the following:
Public washroom Public internet access computers
Children's craft table Puppets and toys
4. The adult reading table is open but limited to three people only.
5. Inside the Library, please keep a minimum distance of 2m (6 feet) from staff and other patrons. This is for your safety and ours.
6. Our free WiFi remains on, but we would ask you to use the WiFi outside the building.
7. Curbside pick-up service is no longer available. For a books-by-mail delivery, please ask staff for help.
8. We ask you to please keep your visit to 15 minutes or less, as we need to make sure everyone has a chance to use the Library.

All rules subject to change depending on orders from the Province of Ontario.
